- I will** be on time to lesson with my equipment and prepared to learn
- I will** always have a go

**As a parent:**

- I will** support my child to attend on time
- I will** help my child be organised for school by having all required learning materials and wearing school uniform
- I will** support my child to engage in learning activities by reinforcing student obligations at home

- Students will be organised for each lesson
- Students will be respectful to everyone
- Students will attend lessons on time
- Students will try their best in class
- Students will respect the learning environment
- Students will be responsible learners

## Staff Responsibilities

- Students will know the learning intentions of each lesson
- Students will be provided with regular feedback
- Students will be acknowledged by name
- Students will be greeted at the door on arrival

## Leadership Responsibilities

- Students will be supported to resolve conflict restoratively
- Students will be offered opportunities to catch up or succeed as required
- Students, families and carers are valued part of our community

## Parent / Guardian Responsibilities

- Students will be supported to attend school and be on time
- Students will be supported to be organised for school and have school uniform
- Students will be encouraged to engage in learning activities
