



UNIFORM POLICY

The Findon High School uniform has been endorsed by the Governing Council in accordance with regulations for its development and approval. The approved supplier is Hambours, 2 Wilson Street, Royal Park, SA.

Our Governing Council has given **three main reasons for this policy** and the strong support it enjoys.

- The wearing of uniform is widely regarded as a positive means of building a school community, one in which the parents and students have real pride and a sense of ownership.
- The use of uniform is an affordable alternative to wearing casual clothes. Our school's uniform committee of students, staff and parents ensures that our uniform items are reasonably priced and appropriate for the school environment
- To ensure students' safety it is helpful to have all our students easily identifiable through the wearing of uniform.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS YEARS 7-12

Students are expected to wear correct school uniform at all times, including excursions and to and from school

Shirts	White short or long sleeved with or without logo (Tie optional)
Polo Shirt	Charcoal short sleeved with logo – <i>new item 2022</i>
Pants	Charcoal Pants – denim or cargo pants are not acceptable
Track Pants	Black tapered leg with FHS emblem – <i>new item 2022</i>
Shorts	Charcoal Shorts
Sport Shorts	Black shorts with FHS emblem – <i>available in term 4 2022</i>
Dress	Checked – the prescribed length of the dress is no shorter than the top of the knee
Skirt	Tartan – the prescribed length of the skirt is no shorter than the top of the knee
Jumper	Charcoal Wool blend V Neck with logo - currently unavailable for purchase
Windcheater	Charcoal crew neck with logo – <i>new item 2022</i>
Spray Jacket	Maroon with logo
Soft Shell Jacket	Grey with logo
Tie	Maroon and white Findon tie (Optional)
Blazer	Maroon with logo – Made to order (Optional)
Socks	Plain short white, black, grey or knee high white
Shoes	Plain black leather/leather-look enclosed shoes
Tights	Plain black, grey or neutral with foot – Not to be worn with socks
House Top	Polo shirt in house colours with house logo
ACCESSORIES	
Baseball Cap	Grey with FHS emblem - not to be worn inside the classroom
Beanie	Grey with FHS emblem - not to be worn inside the classroom

ADDITIONAL UNIFORM OPTIONS FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS (Yr12)

The Graduate 2 students (Yr 12) are permitted to wear a special jacket as determined by the Graduate Coordinator on an annual basis.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Physical Education and Sport: To encourage good personal hygiene habits students **must change clothes** for Physical Education lessons. Students are expected to bring a change of clothes. On most occasions the school will supply appropriate uniforms for sporting teams who compete in our sports programs. Students may still need to provide their own shorts.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT OUR UNIFORM

When are students expected to wear uniform?

- Students are expected to wear full school uniform to and from school every day, unless we have informed you in writing of a special event

Can I purchase my own similar items to replace uniform purchased from the uniform shop?

- Pants are to be school track pants with logo or charcoal trousers, not denim, cord or cargo pants. Jumpers and polo tops must be purchased from the uniform supplier.

Is jewellery permitted to be worn at school?

- Jewellery, including facial piercing, is not encouraged but may be worn only if it is relatively inconspicuous and does not constitute a safety hazard.

No jewellery to be worn in Tech Studies.

Hair must be tied back in Home Ec and Tech Studies

Are students required to wear hats?

- Students are encouraged to wear hats outside in Terms 1 & 4.

Hats are not to be worn inside corridors or classrooms.
